December 6, 1854-April 13, 1917

Willis Richard Glendening, a well-known farmer of the Wheatland colony, died on Friday, April 13th, after an illness of over two years from Bright's disease. For some time past, he had been a great sufferer, but was patient thru it all. Mr. Glendening was born in Harrison county, Mo., Dec. 6, 1854. He was married to Miss Belle Gentry, the wife who survives him, in Plainville, Kansas. To them, twelve children were born, four of whom preceded their father to the better land. Mr. Glendening came with his family to Wheatland 16 years ago and during these years, won the respect of a large circle of friends. Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon from the Christian church, of which organization he had been a member since early youth, Rev. W.L. Wade officiating.
