A Mass of Christian Burial for Gerald Francis Goelz, 20, was held Friday, Oct. 18, 1991, at 10 a.m. at the Saint Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland, with Father John Savio as the Celebrant. Interment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Goelz died Saturday, Oct. 12, 1991 in San Antonio, Tex. He was born Sept. 8, 1971 in Gowanda, N.Y., the son of James and Pauline (Usher) Goelz. He was raised in Gowanda until 1979 when he moved with his family to Wheatland. He graduated from Wheatland High School.
