

**HENRY G. GOERTZ 1982**

Services for Henry G. Goertz, 75, who died in Sun City, Ariz. on Jan. 18, 1982, were held in Wheatland Jan. 22 with burial in the Wheatland Cemetery.

He was born in Hillsboro, Kan., Jan. 21, 1906 and came to Wyoming in 1922 where he went to work for the Swan Land and Cattle Company until the ranch was sold. Mr. Goertz then began farming on his own in the Chugwater area. He also drove a school bus until his retirement four years ago.

On May 19, 1938 he married Sibyl Meeker in Chugwater. The couple spent their winters in Arizona following Mr. Goertz retirement.

Survivors include his wife, Sibyl; his mother, Alice Goertz of Kansas; one daughter, Geraldine Carroll of Glendale, Ariz.; three sisters, Alice Jewell and Lillian Fleenor, both of Kansas, and Florence Milton of Cheyenne; two brothers, Allen Goertz of Wheatland, and Nelson Goertz of Colorado; two grandchildren and one great-grandchild.
