Services for Fred Goetz, 69, who died in Wheatland Dec. 17 were held in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel Dec. 20 at 2:00 P.M. with Dan Barcus officiating.

Goetz was born in Gering, Nebr., Febr. 17, 1916, the son of Adam and Margaret Nickel Goetz. He spent his childhood and attended school in the Wheatland area. In 1941 he and his family moved back to Nebraska where they farmed.

In 1942 he joined the U.S. Army where he worked in demolitions. After being discharged he moved to Vallejo, Calif. to work in the shipyards. Early in the 1950's he moved to Lyman, Nebr. to farm, and later in the 1950's he went to Cheyenne to work for Civil Service on the Air Base.

He returned to Wheatland during the 60's where he farmed until his retirement in 1980, and then spent his retirement years.

He was a member of the Moose Lodge.

Survivors include sons Freddie L. Goetz of Wheatland, Jerry, Jimmy and Steven Goetz, all of Vallejo, Calif., daughters Shirley Harbert of Goodyear, Ariz., Margaret Lohre of Renton, Wash., Patty Lawley of Napa, Calif., brother Adam Goetz Jr. of Utah, sister Laura Foster of Kansas City, Mo., eight grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Preceding him in death were his parents and two sisters.
