

GOLDSMITH, PETER
November 29, 1834-November 15, 1904

Peter Goldsmith died at the home ranch near Dover, on Tuesday, November 15th at 8:10 a.m. after a lingering illness of several weeks.

The deceased was born in Hamilton county, Ohio, November 29, 1834, being 70 years of age at the time of his death. He moved to Iowa with his parents in 1847 where he was united in marriage to Eva Sommers December 10, 1847. To this union, eight children were born, three boys and five girls, seven of whom are still living, as follows: Mrs. D. Naffziger of Morgan Hill, California; J.S. Goldsmith of Denver, Colorado; Mrs. G.W. Brandon and Mrs. J.D. Naffziger of Dover; Mrs. B.F. Guy of Cheyenne; and Mrs. J.J. Craig and H.B. Goldsmith of this place.

Mr. Goldsmith came to Wyoming in March, 1883, and has resided here continuously since. He was a member of the Mennonite church, and was held in highest esteem by all his acquaintances, being a pleasant neighbor and a kind and devoted husband and father.

Funeral services were held in the Congregational church yesterday, Rev. J.W. Moore conducting the same, and interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
