

GONZALEZ, LIBRADA MORALES

November 3, 1891-April 29, 1954

Last rites of the Catholic church were held at St. Patrick's church last Saturday morning for Mrs. Felix Gonzales, who succumbed at a local hospital, April 29, following a lengthy illness. Fr. Clement Orth officiated at the funeral service. Rosary services were held at the Schrader chapel at 7:30 p.m., Friday, April 30.

Born in Mexico November 3, 1891, Librada M. Gonzales was sixty-two years of age at the time of her death. She had been a resident of Uva and Wheatland since 1923.

Survivors are her husband Felix H. of Wheatland; ten daughters, Amelia Medina, Angelina Cancino, Lupe Campos, and Virginia Sanchez, all of Wheatland, Eva Apodoca, Sunrise, Mary Juarez, Denver, Colo., and Hope, Rose Mary, Dora and Delores, all at home. Three brothers and one sister, all in Mexico and fifteen grandchildren.
