

GOODRICH, MARY J. LIGHT
February 11, 1870-March 7, 1895

Mrs. Mary J. Goodrich, wife of C.Z. Goodrich, died at the family home, northeast of Wheatland a few miles, yesterday morning, March 7. Funeral services were held at the schoolhouse in Wheatland today, conducted by Rev. A.A. Brown, and were very largely attended. Mrs. Goodrich had been stricken for a few months past with consumption, and although everything within the power of loving friends had been done to arrest the progress of the disease, the efforts were without avail, and she steadily grew worse until death relieved her suffering. Mr. and Mrs. Goodrich came to Wheatland from Colorado in June of last year, and in their brief residence here, the deceased had formed many ties of friendship. She was of a kind, gentle and loving disposition, admired and esteemed by all acquaintances, and it seems doubly sad that she should thus be removed in the prime of life from a happy home in which love and affection were the only attributes.

Mrs. Mary J. Light Goodrich was born February 11, 1870 in Warsaw, Indiana. She was married to Clement Z. Goodrich March 17, 1891, at Warsaw, and immediately moved to Colorado where they lived until coming to Wheatland. The deceased was a member of the Free Methodist church at Loraine, Indiana. Besides the husband, the only living relative is a sister living in Jonesboro, Indiana, the parents of the deceased having died when she was but a child.
