

GOOLSBY, ETHELYN LYONS
February 1, 1873-December 31, 1932

Mrs. Ellis W. Goolsby died at the home of her son, Glen N. Kline, in the north part of Wheatland, Saturday, December 31, after a short illness with the flu, although she had been a sufferer with asthma for a number of years.

The funeral was conducted Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Copley undertaking parlors by Rev. Dwight M. Kitch, pastor of the M.E. church.

Etheylyn Lyons was born in Omaha, Nebraska, February 1, 1873. October 5, 1891, she was married to Ernest Kline, who passed away December 12, 1900. To this union were born four children, Carl W. Kline of New Raymer, Colo., Mrs. Eunice A. Burns of Kimball, Nebraska, W.T. Kline of Omaha, Nebraska and Glen N. Kline of Wheatland, all four of whom were able to attend the funeral. She is also survived by her husband, Ellis W. Goolsby, to whom she was married April 1, 1907 and by two sisters, Mrs. Vivian A. Kline of Alderwood Manor, Washington and Mrs. Eugenia Brooks of Rawlins, Wyoming. The deceased was a life-long member of the Methodist church and a faithful christian.

Her daughter-in-law, Mrs. Glen N. Kline, is best known in Wheatland as Miss Frances Belcher, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Ed Belcher.
