

GRAEFE, OLLIE MAE MCMULLIN
October 10, 1905-November 7, 1986

Services for Ollie Mae Graefe, 81, who died in Denver, Colorado on November 7, 1986, were held in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel, Tuesday, November 11 at 10:30 a.m. with the Reverend Jim Vuocolo officiating.

Ollie Mae Graefe was born in Rockport, Illinois on October 10, 1905, the daughter of William H. and Lila Davis McMullin. At an early age she moved with her family to Chugwater where they homesteaded. She graduated from Wheatland High School then attended the University of Wyoming where she received her teaching certificate. She taught school for 10 years in the Antelope Gap area. She and Gus Graefe were married in Wheatland in 1935. He died in 1974 and she spent her retirement in Wheatland.

She was a member of the United Church of Christ and the Dorcas Society.

She is survived by daughters: Linda Eikenberry of Englewood, Colorado and Norma Nelson of Lakewood, Colorado; sisters: Irene Chase of Wheatland and Iona Smith of Sacramento, California; and three grandchildren.

Besides her husband and parents she was preceded in death by two brothers: Ralph and Lester.
