Funeral Services for Cleta Blanche Graham were held Saturday, April 16, 1994, at 10:00 a.m. at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints in Wheatland with Elder Howard Bradby officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Mrs. Graham, a long-time resident of Wheatland, died Sunday, April 10, 1994, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

She was born June 2, 1919, in Burlington, Wyoming, the daughter of Charles B. and Myrtle (Bateman) Tanner. She received her early education in Burlington. She moved to Wheatland in May of 1934.

Cleta married Harold LeRoy Graham on May 23, 1936, in Wheatland, and they lived there until the time of their deaths. Cleta loved working and worked for Howard Fish for many years.

Cleta was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Harold on April 14, 1979; two sons, Robert and Billy; four brothers and two sisters.
