Gladys E. Graham, 80, died Oct. 27 at Bethesda Care Center. She was born Dec. 18, 1909 in Wheatland, the daughter of Charles and Carrie (Borral) Hightower. She attended public schools in Wheatland and graduated from Wheatland High School. She attended the University of Wyoming.
