

Roy Graham

H.L. "Roy" Graham passed away on Saturday, April 14, 1979, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital at the age of 64.

Roy was born to Lewis and Daisy Graham on March 4, 1915 at Harrison, Arkansas. Roy married Cleta Tanner on May 23, 1936 at Wheatland.

Roy had been a resident in the Wheatland area since 1929. He was born in Arkansas and then moved to Missouri as a young child with his parents. He came to Wheatland when he was 14. As a young man, he ranched in the Laramie plains until the middle 1930's. After he and Cleta were married, they moved to the Wheatland area. He worked at the Wheatland Elevator and was associated with various feed and ranch operations in this area. Because of ill health, he was forced into semi-retirement the past few years.
