

GRANT, GEORGE R. S.
February 22, 1897-March 30, 1974

George R.S. Grant, a lifetime resident of Wheatland, passed away Saturday, March 30, 1974, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital following an extended illness.

George was born in Wheatland February 22, 1897, and exchanged vows with Margaret C. Keenan on October 17, 1933 at Marshalltown, Iowa. He was a retired rancher and a member of the Wyoming Historical Society and St. Patrick's Catholic Church.

Mr. Grant is survived by three daughters; Mrs. John (Dorothy) Mattive, Brighton, Colo., Mrs. Fred (Mickey) McGuire, Wheatland, Mrs. James (Georgia) Reader, Littleton, Colo.; three sisters, Mrs. Arthur Klinc, Cheyenne, Mrs. C.V.
