

GRAY, RACHEL CLARISEA COAN  
1832-November 23, 1914

Mrs. Rachel Clarisea Gray, aged 83 years, widow of the late Dr. Gray, died in Cheyenne on Monday, Nov. 23, from cerebral hemorrhage. The body was brought to Wheatland Tuesday morning and funeral services held from the M.E. church, of which organization she had been a life long member and the mortal remains were laid to rest by the side of her husband who departed this life some ten years ago.

Dr. and Mrs. Gray were among the early settlers of Wheatland, having located here 16 years ago. During their long residence among Wheatland people, they won the affectionate respect of a large circle of friends and acquaintances. Mrs. Gray was the grandmother of Chas. L. Rigdon of Cheyenne and step-mother of Mrs. S.G. Hopkins of Cheyenne, Mrs. I.N. Pence, Roland Gray and I.W. Gray of this place, besides numerous other relatives. She went to Cheyenne about a month ago and while there was stricken with her final illness. She was a native of Carroll county, Indiana.

After a long, busy and useful life, Mrs. Gray died as she had lived, a faithful follower of the Christian faith, honored, loved and trusted.
