

GREENLEE, CLARA PEARL GLENDENNING

May 8, 1891-October 7, 1919

MRS. GREENLEE DIES LAST WEEK

Among the saddest occurrences in this vicinity for some time was the death of Mrs. Earnest Greenlee, which occurred at 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday of last week.

Mrs. Greenlee had been ill with tuberculosis for nearly a year as the immediate result of an attack of influenza last winter. During the summer, she went to Arizona to try the altitude, which affected her heart to such an extent that she returned within a month.

She was born in Stockton, Kansas, May 8, 1891, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Glendenning, who were formerly well-known here. The family moved to Wheatland in 1901, where Miss Clara Pearl Glendenning was married to Ernest Greenlee in 1903. Four boys were born to this union, Elmer, aged 10, Frank, aged 9, Raymond, aged 7, and Jay Gentry, aged 6.

Her father and brother had died from the same disease at the local hospital several years ago.
