

GUENTHER, MARY LUCILLE REED
November 14, 1900-December 30, 1977

Services for Mary Lucille Guenther, 77, were held January 2, 1978 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Church of Christ with Delbert Dick officiating. Interment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Guenther died December 20, 1977 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland. She was born November 14, 1900 in Hebron, Nebraska. She graduated from high school in Nebraska and moved to Lingle where her parents had homesteaded. She taught at the Doty School southwest of Lingle for several years. She married Harry Lowes Guenther September 3, 1924 in Torrington. They lived briefly in Casper, Cheyenne, and Rawlins prior to moving to Wheatland in 1940.

Mrs. Guenther was Past Grand Guardian of Jobs Daughters and Past President of the American Legion Auxiliary. She was a member of the Order of Eastern Star of Wheatland and the Dorcas Society. She was a member of the United Church of Christ.

Mrs. Guenther is survived by one sister Mrs. G.O. (Ann) Nixson. She was preceded in death by her husband, Harry in March, 1977; three brothers, Jim, Hobart and Wilbur Reed.
