

Henry Gustafson Passes Away March 2nd

85, of Chugwater, passed away
Friday, March 2, 1973 at Cheyenne after an extended illness.

Mr. Gustafson was born in Skara, Sweden, May 10, 1887. He came to America at the age of 17 and joined his brothers in Iowa.

In 1908 Henry came to Wyoming to homestead west of Chugwater. Later he started to work for the C and S Railroad and continued this employment until his retirement in 1953. He served in World War I.

In 1920 he married Bertha Royal. To this union was born four daughters; Mrs. Clinton (Helen) Dunning, Mrs. Russell (Wyona) Chasteen, Mrs. Boyd (Betty) Ash, and Mrs. Sheldon (Jean) Henderson. His widow and this immediate family survive him. Also seven grand children & several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and eight brothers.

He had a great interest in the American Legion and helped to organize the Post in Chugwater. He was a member of the Wyoming Consistory, the Masonic Lodge No. 23, Laurel Leaf Chapter. No. 25, and the Luthern Church in Sweden.

Funeral services were held Monday, March 5, 1973 at 11:00 a.m. at the Methodist Church with Rev. Charles Clough officiating. Burial was at the Wheatland Cemetery. Pallbearers were Louis Voight, L. A. Warn, Sterling Bostwick, John Chasteen, Dick McMillan and Roger Sneesby.
