

Ethel Guthrie, 83 Passes Away Last Monday

Mrs. Ethel Edna Guthrie, a resident of Wheatland since 1901, passed away at the Platte County Memorial Hospital on Monday, June 26, 1972 after an extended illness. Mrs. Guthrie was 83, and was born in Mayfield, Kentucky on June 20, 1889. She was a member of the Baptist Church.
