

# ***JIM PETER HINTZ***

April 9, 1954 ~ May 4, 2021 (age 67)

A graveside service for Jim Peter Hintz, 67, was held at 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, May 5, 2021 at the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland, Wyoming with Reverend Tom Sterneman officiating.

Jim Hintz passed away peacefully and free from pain on Tuesday, May 4, 2021, at the Davis Hospice Center in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Jim was born on Thursday, April 9, 1954, in Madison, Wisconsin, the son of Ernest Rheinhold and Margaret (Adam) Hintz. He grew up in Indianapolis, Indiana.
