

JACKSON, BENJAMIN NIMROD  
September 3, 1880-April 27, 1957

Benjamin "Ben" Nimrod Jackson, age 76, passed away at the Wheatland General Hospital April 27, 1957, following an extended illness. Mr. Jackson was born near Slater, Missouri September 3, 1880, and had made his home here since 1917.

He was a well known and loved figure at the local schools, having served as janitor for many years. When Mr. Jackson first came to Wheatland, he was employed at the roller mill.

He is survived by his wife, Lula Belle Jackson of Wheatland; two sons, Marvin D. Jackson, St. Louis, Mo. and Viro C. Jackson of Glasgow, Mont.; one daughter, Mrs. Leona Howard, Enid, Okla., and one step-son, Arthel O. Graves of Wheatland. One brother, Peter S. Jackson of Higginsville, Mo. and thirteen grandchildren as well as eleven great grandchildren also survive. One son preceded him in death.

Funeral services were held from the Schrader Chapel Tuesday at 4:00 p.m. with Rev. J.B. Milstead officiating. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with pallbearers being J.E. Foreman, Russell Fish, Sam Edmiston, Lon Stephens, Jerry Waitman and Tom Tugman.
