Funeral services for Donald Carver Jewett were held Monday, February 28, 1977, at the Schrader-Prell Chapel with First Reader, Mrs. Bayard Wilson officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Jewett died Friday, February 25, 1977 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital at the age of 85.
