

Dorothy Virginia Jewett

February 9, 1915-June 8, 2002

Graveside services and interment for Dorothy Virginia Jewett, 87, were held June 15 at the Wheatland Cemetery with Denis Van Patten of First Church of Christ, Scientist, officiating.

Mrs. Jewett died June 8 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Dorothy was born Feb. 9, 1915, in Denver, the daughter of Guy Statton and Hazel (Wasley) Pease. She was reared and educated in Platteville, Colo., and other communities in Colorado. She graduated from Platteville High School, then attended business school in Denver for two years.

Dorothy married Don C. Jewett in Cheyenne January 1, 1937. They began ranching in the Laramie Plains area and then purchased a ranch in Wendover, Wyo. In the early 1940's, residing there until her death.

Dorothy loved animals and was in charge of the cattle and calving.

She also enjoyed cats, dogs, gardening, flowers and canning.

She was a member of the Christian Science Mother Church in Boston, Mass. Dorothy corresponded regularly with friends and relatives.
