

JOHNSON, JAMES L.
September 16, 1861-March 6, 1934

James L. Johnson, a resident of the Sybille country for the past 34 years, passed away at his home Tuesday evening, March 6th. The deceased had been ill for the past four years.

James L. Johnson was born at Iowa Falls, Iowa, September 1861. When 22 years of age, he came to Colorado and in the spring of 1898, he moved to Wyoming. In 1900, he settled in the Sybille district and engaged in the sheep and cattle business there since that time.

He is survived by a sister, Mrs. Lester Cline of Nunn, Colo., and one son, Fred Johnson of the Sybille district. He is also survived by seven grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon from the Lyla Watson Funeral home. Rev. Kitch was in charge of the services. Interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery.
