

Jeremiah Grizzly 'Griz' Johnson

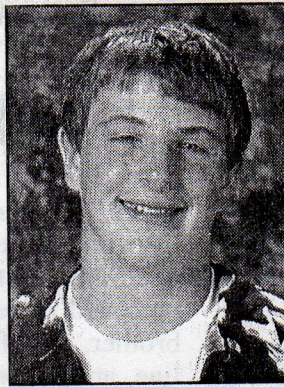
September 20, 1989 - May 1, 2005
