

JOHNSON, JOHN WESLEY
March 16, 1889-January 24, 1961

Funeral services will be conducted Friday, January 27, at 2:00 p.m. for John Wesley Johnson, who passed away at Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne, January 24. Rev. Robert French will officiate at the services from the Methodist Church in Wheatland. Graveside services in the Wheatland Cemetery will be conducted by the IOOF Lodge.

Mr. Johnson was born in Salem, Ill., March 16, 1889, the son of Peter B. and Martha Ellen Wham Johnson. Coming here from Centralia, Ill. In 1919, he homesteaded east of Wheatland, where he engaged in ranching. He is survived by his wife, Anna, whom he married in 1923.

He was a member of the IOOF-Rebekah Lodge, being a Past Grand and Past District Deputy of IOOF.
