

**Mrs. Mary Johnson  
Pioneer Of Section  
Passes On**

**Was Settler In Horseshoe Creek  
Section In The Early 80's**

Mrs. Mary Johnson, well known pioneer of this district and a resident in the state since 1882, died Monday evening after a long illness.

Mary Marguerite Johnson was born in Sweden Feb. 23, 1859, and died on April 6, 1925 at Wheatland, Wyo., aged 66 years, one month and eight days.

She was married to Johnson in November, 1876 at Cedarvale Cedaralles, Sweden in the Swedish Lutheran church. Five children were born to them, of whom two, Anna Johnson Tisch, and Victor Johnson were born before they left Sweden. In 1881 they came to America, coming directly to Cheyenne where they remained for a short time only, and then moved to a homestead on Horseshoe creek. Here three more children were born, Minnie, Oscar and Mary. Of these, Minnie and Oscar died some years ago.

From the homestead on Horseshoe they moved to a pre-emption near Glendo, and from there to Mule Creek. From the latter place they moved to Wheatland about 20 years ago, where Mrs. Johnson resided until her death.

She was confirmed in the Swedish Lutheran church while still young, and never withdrew her membership from that communion, altho for years she had been a regular attendant at the Congregational church here.
