Funeral services for ⁵⁻¹¹⁻¹⁹⁹⁴ Koreen B. Jones, age 89, were held Monday, May 16, 1994, at 11 a.m., at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with the Rev. Linda Barnes-Patzke of Wheatland United Methodist Church officiating. Interment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Jones died Wednesday, May 11, 1994 at Michael Manor in Douglas, Wyo., where she had resided for the past five and one-half years.

Koreen was born Oct. 11, 1904 in Floyd County, Va., the daughter of Percy J. and Lucy Lee (Walton) Booth. She came to Wyoming in 1920, and graduated from Wheatland High School in 1922.

She was an accomplished pianist and musician and played for church services, weddings, dance bands and the Senior Kitchen Band. She could write impromptu lyrics for any occasion.

Her secretarial skills were utilized in many offices, and she worked on various newspapers throughout Wyoming. She served as clerk for two sessions of the Legislature.

Koreen was a charter member of the Farm Bureau Woman's Club, and was a life-long member of the Wheatland United Methodist Church. She loved her sisters, music, flowers, animals and good times.

She is survived by two sisters, Virginia Barrett of Wheatland, and Mildred Holben and husband, Wallis, of Cheyenne. Also surviving are a niece, Bette Adams of Sheridan, Wyo., five grand-nieces and nephews, Michael Campbell of Williams, Ariz., C. Kay McCain of Big Bear Lake, Calif., Dixie Banks of St. Louis, Mo., Judy Robinson of Las Vegas, Nev., and Monty Worthington of Gillette, Wyo, 12 great-grandnieces and nephews and one great-great-grandnephew.

She was preceded in death by her parents.
