

JORDAN, EDWARD A.  
October 21, 1866-February 22, 1941

E.A. Jordan, one of Wheatland's oldest and well-known residents, passed away Saturday, February 22, at the age of seventy-four years and four months.

Edward A. Jordan was born in Indiana on October 21, 1866, but for many years made his home in Wheatland. "Ed" as he was known to his friends, was a well-known figure here as he served as a dreyman for the Wheatland community for a good many years. The last few months of his life he spent at the home of Harry Royce until the destruction of the latter's home by fire. Since that time, Ed became ill and in just a few weeks, passed away.

Surviving him are three sons and one daughter: Lawrence of Wheatland, Myriel of Lusk, Raymond of Grand Junction, Colo. and Mrs. Florence Clapper whose home is in California.

Services were conducted Monday afternoon from the Watson and Dennis chapel with Rev. C.B. Doughty officiating. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
