

JORDAN, RUBY MAUD HINES
February 16, 1899-July 1, 1966

A short illness claimed the life of Ruby Maud Jordan at the Bath Israel Hospital in Denver, Colo. on July 1, 1966. She was born in Lewis, Ia. Feb. 16, 1899 and moved to Wheatland in 1909 where she married Lawrence V. Jordan on November 23, 1916. Mrs. Jordan was a member of the Methodist church and the Neighbors of Woodcraft.
