Services for Barney J. Juarez, 71, who died in Cheyenne, Dec. 29, 1987, were held in St. Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland Monday, Jan. 4, 1988, at 10 a.m. with Father Malcolm Reid officiating. The Rosary Service was held in the church Sunday evening at 7 p.m.

Born in Haskell, Texas, June 5, 1916, he was the son of Lucio and Guadalupe S. (Jimenez) Juarez. When he was young he moved with his family to Wheatland. For a period of time he worked for the Great Western sugar factory and also at the CF&I Mine in Sunrise.

In 1942 he entered the U.S. Army and upon being discharged he returned to Wheatland. He and Marv Truiillo were married in Scottsbluff, Neb., July 21, 1943. In 1959 he went to work for the Colorado & Southern Railroad where he worked until his retirement.

He was a member of the Catholic Church and the Moose Lodge.

Besides his wife, Nancy of Wheatland, he is survived by sons Carlos, Arthur and Benny Juarez of Cheyenne, daughters Phyllis Mojica, Rita Juarez and Martha Hassler of Wheatland, Bonnie Gisse of Cheyenne and Lucy Juarez of Casper, brother Mike Sanchez of Denver, sisters Antonia Kelsev of Maywood, Calif. and Marie Pierce of Riverside Calif., and 18 grandchildren, including Jarrod Barney, who was born the day of Juarez's death.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
