

8-15 **Thomas Lloyd Judah** 1992

Funeral Services for Thomas Lloyd Judah, 82, were held Tuesday, August 18, 1992 at 2:30 p.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Pastor Tim Ricker and Pastor Randy Kuhn officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Judah died after a lengthy illness, Saturday, August 15 at the Iverson Memorial Hospital in Laramie.

He was born September 8, 1909 in Faucett, Missouri to Wyne and Minnie E. (Clinkenbeard) Judah. He was raised and educated in Missouri and moved to Colorado in 1935.
