Funeral services for Kenneth L. Judd, 89, were Tuesday, Jan. 5, 1993 at the All Saints Episcopal Church in Wheatland, with the Reverend Karin E. Wade officiating. Interment was to be at a later time at the Wheatland Cemetery. Mr. Judd died Thursday, Dec. 31, 1992 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland following a short illness.

He was born May 19, 1903 in Wheat Ridge, Colorado the son of Joel Augustus and Lillian Abbey (West) Judd. He was reared and educated in Colorado, and attended and graduated from Wheatland High School in 1921. He went to California for several years, and then returned to Wheatland in the mid 1930's. He and his brother owned and operated the Judd Motor Company. He was married to Wilma L. Goering on December 5, 1940 in Scottsbluff, Nebraska. In 1940 they moved to Casper, where he worked for Casper Battery and Casper Auto and Electric. In 1949 they returned to Wheatland where he worked for Grease Spot/Logan and Krueger Motors, and then for Marker's retiring in 1966. He remained a resident of Wheatland until the time of his death. He was a member of All Saints Episcopal Church; Mayflower Society, a direct descendant of Priscilla and John Alden who came to America on the Mayflower; Wheatland Masonic Lodge #16 in which he had held several offices; and the Order of Eastern Star.

He is survived by his son, Jerald Judd of Gilbert, Arizona; and two grandchildren, Kenny J. Judd and Lendora R. Judd both of Casper.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife on Dec. 22, 1979; two sisters, and two brothers.
