

JUDD, WILMA LENDORA GOERING

May 27, 1908- December 22, 1979

Wilma Lendora Judd, age 71, passed away, Saturday, Dec. 22, 1979, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Wilma Goering was born on May 27, 1908 in Marion County, Iowa to Henry and Mary Hartz Goering. Wilma was married to Kenneth Judd on Dec. 5, 1940 in Scottsbluff, Neb.

Wilma came with her family to homestead on the Slater Flats in 1911. She was reared in Slater and was educated in the Wheatland Schools. She moved to Wheatland in 1919 and started at the phone company in April of 1930 where she worked for 35 years.

Wilma and Kenneth lived all their married life in Wheatland except for eight years, 1941-1949, when they lived in Casper where she was Chief Service Observer for the Telephone Company.

She has been active in her hobbies, gardening and knitting. She was a member of the All Saints Episcopal Church in Wheatland, Telephone Pioneers, B & PW, Order of the Eastern Star, and All Saints Episcopal Church Guild.

Wilma is survived by her husband, Kenneth, of Wheatland; one son, Jerry of Casper; two brothers, Floyd Goering of Torrington, and R.E. "Tug" Goering of Tucson, Ariz.; one sister, Evelyn Nickeson of Kinnear; also two grandchildren, Kenneth James Judd of Casper and Lendora Renee Judd of Casper.

Funeral services were held Dec. 27, 1979, at 10:30 a.m. at the All Saints Episcopal Church in Wheatland. Father Sidney Hoadley officiated. Cremation followed.
