

JUDSON, BERTHA RICHARDS
November 12, 1891-October 13, 1979

Funeral services for Bertha Judson were held at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home on Tuesday, Oct. 16, 1979, at 1:30 p.m. with Elder Marvin Lauck officiating, assisted by Patriarch Merlin O'Haver.

Mrs. Judson passed away at the Wheatland Hospital on Saturday. She was born the daughter of Mary and William Richards on Nov. 12, 1891 in Higby, Missouri. She grew up in Bevier, Missouri. As a young woman, Bertha moved to Des Moines, Iowa to work. There she met and married E.C. Judson on Jan. 2, 1918.

She and her husband moved to Wyoming in 1920. She and Mr. Judson homesteaded 35 miles Northwest of Douglas. She had been a resident of Wheatland since 1941.

She was a pioneer lady. She was a member of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.

Mrs. Judson was preceded in death by her husband, Elza; two sons, Dean and Elbert; three sisters and one brother. She is survived by two daughters. Mrs. Ed (Allene) Mers and Mrs. Bud (Betty) Dower, both of Wheatland; 17 grandchildren and 18 great grandchildren.

Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery with Merlin O'Haver of Alva officiating.
