

JUSCHKA, ALFRED MARTIN
November 10, 1915-May 8, 1989

Services for Alfred Martin Juschka, 73, who died in Casper May 8, 1989, were held Thursday, May 11, 1989, in the Trinity Lutheran Church at 10:30 a.m. with Pastor Randal Golter officiating.

Born Nov. 10, 1915, in Burlington County, Iowa, he was the son of Frederick M. and Minnie (Bartschat) Juschka. At the age of three he moved with his parents to Wheatland. He was educated in the rural schools in the Wheatland area.

He farmed on the southwest flats until 1975 when he retired and moved to town to spend his retirement years. He was one of the first security guards at the power plant.

In April of 1937, he and Leslie Jessen were married at the farm near Wheatland.

He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church.

Survivors include his wife, Leslie Juschka of Wheatland, sons Fred and Vern Juschka of Wheatland, daughter Linda Wyman of Buffalo, brother Elmer Juschka of Wheatland, four granddaughters and two grandsons.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery with Jim Schindler, Bjorn Nilsson, Wade Mitchel, Fritz Huckfeldt, Einer Mickelsen and Adam Lofing serving as pallbearers.
