A funeral service for Leslie Mae Juschka, 91, was conducted on May 17, 2010, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Reverend Lincoln Winter officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She died Wednesday, May 12, 2010, at the Cheyenne Healthcare Center in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Leslie was born January 3, 1919, in Wheatland, Wyoming, the daughter of Martin and Laura (McGuire) Jessen. She was reared and educated in Wheatland, graduating in 1936 from Wheatland High School. On April 18, 1937, she married Alfred Martin Juschka in Wheatland. She and her husband farmed on the South Flats in the Wheatland area. Leslie was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church where she was active with the Ladies Aid of the church. She was devoted to her church being baptized, confirmed, married, and buried from Trinity Lutheran. She was an avid reader of the Bible, both morning and evening. Leslie was a wonderful seamstress and cook. In

her later years she began quilting.

Survivors include two children, Vern Juschka of Wheatland and Linda Wyman of Westminster Colorado; a sister, Ella Burzlaff of Wheatland five grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents husband on May 8, 1989; a son, Frederick Martin Juschka on July 26, 1992; three sisters, Mabe Miller, Elizabeth Bohl, and Hazel Klein; two brothers, Alvin Jessen and Glenn Jessen and a grandson, Quent Juschka on September 16, 1997.
