

KAFKA, DUANE KAY
September 20-1941-October 24, 1951

Bulbar polio took the lives of Sylva A. Kafka, 13-year-old Wheatland girl last Saturday, October 20 at a local hospital and her brother, Duane 10, late Wednesday, October 24 at the Casper Memorial Hospital. Both were children of Beula Kafka and Joseph Kafka.

Sylva, born in Wheatland January 5, 1938 was in the eighth grade and a member of the Christian church.

Duane, who was born in Laramie, September 20, 1941 was in the fourth grade.

Private services for Sylva were held Sunday at Schraders, the Rev. Henry Heaton officiating and interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Schraders will return the body of Duane to Wheatland today (Thursday) and private services will be conducted Friday afternoon at 2:00'clock. Burial will be made in the Wheatland cemetery beside his sister, with Mr. C.E. Henry officiating.

Survivors of the two children include their parents; two brothers, Douglas and Neil; and two sisters, Marilyn and Sharon.
