

Daniel George Laher

Daniel Laher was born on Aug. 22, 1936 to Arthur Franklin and Dorothy Marion (Rothamer) Laher in Medford, Wisconsin, the oldest of seven children.

Dan moved to Wyoming in the late 1950's and made his living by farming and raising livestock around the Glenrock, Douglas, and Wheatland, Wyoming areas. He married Louise Marie Sanmann of Lusk on Nov. 28, 1959 and together they had four sons and four daughters and are grandparents to nineteen grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren. He was very generous to his grandchildren and great-grandchildren, never missing a birthday or Christmas gift.

Dan enjoyed a simple rural life east of Wheatland during his retirement years. Dan was a firearms enthusiast and collector. He loved to work on tractors and was an avid reader. He also collected stamps and coins and enjoyed going to auc-

tions. He loved animals and had adopted several outdoor cats.

Dan was a veteran of the United States Navy and a devoted member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland.
