

LAMB, CHARLEY H.

All of Platte County was shocked to learn of the death of a friend and public official, C.H. Lamb, 72, of Guernsey, Wednesday morning as he sat in his chair at his home.

Charley, as he insisted he wanted to be called, first entered politics when he chose to serve as County Commissioner. He filed on the Democratic ticket for the 1958 primary and went on to the general election where he was elected. He was reelected in 1962 for a four year term.

Charley had been a resident of the county for forty years, and was a retired railroad man. He was on the Burlington railroad for 27 years as construction and maintenance man. He was also a rancher in the Wendover area for many years.

Last rites will be Saturday at 2 p.m. in Guernsey Community church with burial in Wheatland.
