

## George Lambert dies from injuries

George Franklin Lambert, who was critically injured in an accident three weeks ago, succumbed in the Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne on December 3, 1963. Mr. Lambert, who had been employed at the Wheatland Elevator for the past six years, was injured when his clothing became entangled in the machinery where he worked.

The deceased, who had been a Wheatland resident for 35 years, was born to Mr. and Mrs. William M. Lambert in Sweet Springs, Mo. April 16, 1899. Services will be in charge of Rev. Robert Johnson at the Schrader chapel on Friday, Dec. 6th at 10:30 a.m., with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.
