

LAMBERT, MAY KRUSE
October 12, 1901-March 31, 1958

Last rites were held from the Baptist Church in Wheatland, Monday at 2:00 p.m. for May Lambert, 55, wife of James E. Lambert. Mrs. Lambert passed away at Rawlins, Sept. 7, following an extended illness. She was visiting with her daughter at the time of her death.
