

Ethyl Elizabeth Lamborn 1911 to 1996

Memorial services for Ethyl Elizabeth Lamborn, 84, were held Thursday, Feb. 1 at 1 p.m. at the United Church of Christ in Wheatland, with Reverend Richard S. Putney officiating.

Internment was at the Wheatland Cemetery. Lamborn died Monday, Jan. 29, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital. Born August 24, 1911, in Kirwin, Kansas, she was the daughter of Vernon Franklin and Rosa Emma (Hornish) Chandler.

The family lived in Clay Center, Neb., for a short time before moving to Humboldt, Neb., where Lamborn graduated from high school in 1929.

After high school, she attended and graduated from the Lincoln School of Commerce in Lincoln, Neb. Lamborn was working for the Nebraska Hardware Mutual Insurance Company in Lincoln when she met her future husband. Lamborn married Raymond A. Lamborn July 9, 1933, in Bennet, Neb. They moved to Wheatland in 1948. She worked as the Secretary-Treasurer of Wheatco Refining Company Inc. from 1949 through 1978. She was involved in Campfire Girls for many years.

A member of the United Church of Christ, she served as treasurer for 13 years. She was also an active member of the Dorcas Society of the PEO Chapter AW and the Wheatland Study Club. She served as the Vice-Chairman of Platte County Republican Party.

Lamborn enjoyed handiwork and loved to play bridge. A very tolerant and kind woman, she loved children and, in particular, dogs.

Lamborn is survived by her husband, Raymond A. Lamborn; a daughter, Donna Cassin of San Jose, Calif.; two sisters and two brothers, Velma Irene Gunderson of Denver, Colo., Kenneth Gordon Chandler of Covina, Calif., Dean Leroy Chandler of Bronson, Mich., Dona Belle Thompson of Humboldt, Neb.; four grandchildren, Deborah Rane Stiegers of Sacramento, Calif., David Blake Hutchinson of Ruth, Nev., Diana Rae Gabriellini of Santa Clara, Calif., and Deidre Ann Lavrador of Woodland, Calif. and one great granddaughter, Sarah Elizabeth Cannon of Sacramento.

She was preceded in death by her parents, three brothers, William Joseph Chandler, Ivan Ward Chandler, and Raymond Roy Chandler; and two sisters, Loretta Grace Fankhouser and Helen Lee Augusta Flachsbarth.
