

LANE, ZELDA HESTER WOOTEN
November 8, 1910-August 2, 1975

Zelda Hester Wooten was born at Hooper, Nebraska on November 8, 1910 to James L. Wooten and Lida I. Kendrick and passed away at the Boone County Hospital on August 2, 1975 at the age of 64 after a short illness.

She spent her girlhood days in Mamburg, Iowa, and attended school there.

In January of 1929, she was united in marriage to J.C. Dunmire at Rockport, Mo. To this union, 7 children were born. Six survive her: one son, Donald Dunmire of Cheyenne; 5 daughters, Dorothy Cussins of Wheatland, Doris Kolkman of Cheyenne, Betty Girgenti of Detroit, Mich., Kay Karan of Aurora, Colo., and Elsie Lei of Albion, Nebr. One baby daughter died at birth. Her husband, J.C. Dunmire passed away at Wheatland in June of 1962.

On Oct. 5, 1967, she was united in marriage to Wesley B. Lane in Gering, Nebr.
