Roy Shade Large, 84, funeral services will be held Wednesday, August 24, at the Schrader-Prell Chapel with Dan Barcus officiating. Interment will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Large died Monday, August 22, at Laramie. He was born October 28, 1892 in Linwood, Utah. He moved to Wyoming with his family when he was a young boy. He spent most of his lifetime in Ft. Washakie area holding various positions with the U.S. Government working in Indian Affairs. He attended the Carlisle Indian School and was very active in sports and was coached by Pop Warner. He played against Eisenhower when Carlisle played West Point. He was a Veteran of World War II with the U.S. Army.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. June Juschka of Wheatland; two grandchildren, Marlene Dager and Richard Juschka; three great grandchildren, Charles Sharp, Shannon Dager and Roberta Dager.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Margaret Mary Merna in June of 1936. He married his second wife in Seattle, Washington in 1947, she passed away in June of 1975. He was also preceded in death by twelve brothers and sisters.
