**HARRY HENRY LARSCHIED**

Services for <sup>2-14-1982</sup> Harry Henry Larscheid, 76, who died in Wheatland, Feb. 14, were held Friday, Feb. 17 in St. Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland with Father John Murray and Msgr. John Corrigan officiating. A Rosary service was held Feb. 15, in the church.

Harry Larscheid was born May 25, 1907, in Green Bay, Wis. the son of Anton and Pauline Larscheid. At the age of three he moved with his family to Mott, N.D. where his parents filed a homestead.

He was reared on the family farm and attended a rural school near Mott. He and Flora Braun were married in 1934 and farmed with his parents for two years before moving to Sioux Falls, S.D. where he worked for John Morrell Packing Company.

In 1945 they moved to Dell Rapids, S.D. where he was associated with a mink ranch operation until his retirement in 1977. The couple then moved to Wheatland.

He was a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church and the Catholic Order of Foresters.
