

LARSON, GARNETT LEONA COZAD

April 19, 1920-August 4, 2009

A graveside service and interment for Garnett Leona Larson, 89, was conducted on Saturday, August 8, 2009, in the Wheatland Cemetery, at Wheatland, Wyoming with Pastor Delbert Dick officiating.

She died Tuesday, August 4, 2009, at the Cheyenne Life Care Center in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Garnett was born April 19, 1920 in Bartley, Nebraska, the daughter of Henry Clinton and Elsie (Fisher) Cozad. She was reared and educated in Chugwater and on August 11, 1936, married Walter Wayne Larson in Gering, Nebraska. During the war they lived in Washington state, where Mr. Larson welded in a shipyard.
