Funeral services for Catherine Elizabeth "Kate" Lauck, 95, will be held Feb. 20, at 10:30 a.m. at the United Church of Christ in Wheatland, with Reverend Jeff Barton officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Lauck died Feb. 16, at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

She was born Sept. 17, 1906 in Longmont, the sixth child of this large family of seven brothers and three sisters, the daughter of Adam and Catherine Elizabeth (Walter) Stugart. She was reared and educated in Longmont. She was married to Louis Lauck on March 22, 1928 in Longmont. They farmed in the Longmont area until they retired in 1975. They moved into Wheatland, and she resided there until the time of her death. She was a member of the United Church of Christ, the Dorcas Society and the Farm Bureau. She enjoyed growing roses, knitting and crocheting. She had made an afghan for all of

her grandchildren and some of the great grandchildren.

She is survived by her three sons and their wives, Marvin and Geraldine Lauck of Wheatland, Norman "Bud" and Darlene Lauck of Laramie, and Robert "Bob" and Lorretta Lauck of Wheatland; one brother Don Stugart of Denver; nine grandchildren; 21 great grandchildren; and one great-great granddaughter.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Louis on July 10, 1976; six brothers and two sisters.
