Services for Mary Irene Lauk, 75, who died in Wheatland on Sept. 30 were held Tuesday, Oct. 4 at St. Anthony's Catholic Church in Guernsey, Father John Murray officiating. Rosary services were in the church Monday evening.

Lauk was born in Sunrise, Wyoming on March 21, 1908, the daughter of Roman and Theresa Brendl. She was educated in the Guernsey schools, graduating from Guernsey High School in 1927. She taught a country school in Garrett, Wyoming before moving to Denver where she lived until 1942. She then returned to Sunrise and married Rameri C. Lauk in 1946. The couple lived in Sunrise and, after Mr. Lauk passed away in 1958, Mary remained in her home there.

Survivors include her daughter, Elizabeth Van Maren of Mt. Sinai, N. Y.; three brothers, John and Frank Dapra, both of Hartville, and Louis Dapra of Daniel, Wyoming; two sisters Rose Martin of Denver and Ann Stratton of Casper. She was preceded in death by a sister, Theresa Williams and a brother William Dapra, as well as her husband.

A memorial in her name has been established with St. Joseph's Home for Children in Torrington.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
