Rameri Lauk Dies In
Scottsbluff Sunday

Rameri C. Lauk, 63-year old resident of this area since 1913, died in a Scottsbluff hospital Sunday, Feb. 9, following a brief illness.

Mr. Lauk was born in Germany March 13, 1894 and came to this country 45 years ago. He had resided on a small ranch north of Sunrise since that time. Shortly after his arrival in this area he was employed by Colorado Fuel and Iron corporation and for a time worked at the old Chicago Mine. He later attended the University of Wyoming and during World War I he worked as a fireman for the Union Pacific Railroad. When the war ended he took up a homestead north of Sunrise and returned to work at Sunrise mine.

In 1946 he married the former Miss Mary Dapra, who now survives as does one child, Elizabeth.

Funeral services were held from Schrader Chapel in Wheatland at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 11. L. B. Secrest, Episcopal lay reader, officiated and burial was in Wheatland cemetery. Schrader funeral home was in charge of arrangements.
