

LAWRENCE, GRACE ETHEL HARDESTY

January 21, 1907-March 25, 1933

Though sick from Christmas day, the death of Mrs. Frank Lawrence came as a terrific shock to relatives and friends here. Mrs. Lawrence had spent six weeks in the Wheatland hospital where she had been treated for pneumonia. Released from the hospital, she had spent the last month at the home of Mr. Lawrence's mother, Mrs. Maude Nichols in Wheatland. Saturday she accompanied her husband to the ranch to procure some articles and there at 8:45 in the evening she passed peacefully away. Word was sent to Wheatland and an ambulance was rushed to the ranch home. The body was brought to the Lyla Watson Funeral Home.

Grace Ethel Hardesty, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Hardesty, was born January 21, 1907, near Grover, Colorado. She came to Wyoming in 1926 from Henry, Nebraska where her parents still reside. April 10, 1926 she was united in marriage to Frank Lawrence at Torrington, coming to the Wheatland community later. Besides her husband and parents, the deceased is survived by one sister and four brothers; Vera, Wilbur, Charles and Happy of Henry, and John of Boulder City.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Lyla Watson Funeral Home, Reverend Ralph E. Morgan of the Union Congregational church conducting the service. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
